## OLD TESTAMENT

### —LAW—

#### **Genesis —**

##### **Beginnings**

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.  
(Genesis 1:1)

#### **Exodus —**

##### **Deliverance**

The LORD will fight for you; you need only to be still.  
(Exodus 14:14)

#### **Leviticus — Holiness**

Be holy because I, the LORD your God, am holy.  
(Leviticus 19:2)

#### **Numbers —**

##### **Wandering**

The LORD is slow to anger and abounding in loving devotion, forgiving iniquity and transgression.  
(Numbers 14:18)

#### **Deuteronomy —**

##### **Covenant**

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is One.  
(Deuteronomy 6:4)

### —HISTORY—

#### **Joshua — Conquest**

Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.  
(Joshua 1:9)

#### **Judges — Apostasy**

In those days there was no king in Israel; everyone did what was right in his own eyes.  
(Judges 21:25)

#### **Ruth — Redemption**

Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. Your people will be my people, and your God will be my God.  
(Ruth 1:16)

#### **1 Samuel —**

##### **Leadership**

The LORD does not look at the things man looks at. Man looks on the outward appearance, but the LORD looks on the heart.  
(1 Samuel 16:7)

#### **2 Samuel —**

##### **Covenant**

Your house and your kingdom will endure before Me forever, and your throne will be established forever.  
(2 Samuel 7:16)

#### **1 Kings — Division**

If you walk in My ways and keep My statutes and commandments as your father David did, I will prolong your days.  
(1 Kings 3:14)

#### **2 Kings — Exile**

They rejected His statutes and His covenant that He had made with their fathers, and His warnings that He had given them.  
(2 Kings 17:15)

#### **1 Chronicles —**

##### **Heritage**

Seek the LORD and His strength; seek His face always.  
(1 Chronicles 16:11)

#### **2 Chronicles —**

##### **Reformation**

If My people who are called by My name humble themselves

and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, forgive their sin, and heal their land.  
(2 Chronicles 7:14)

#### **Ezra — Restoration**

The hand of the LORD my God was upon me, and I gathered leading men from Israel to go up with me.  
(Ezra 7:28)

#### **Nehemiah —**

##### **Rebuilding**

So we rebuilt the wall until all of it was joined together to half its height, for the people had a mind to work.  
(Nehemiah 4:6)

#### **Esther — Providence**

And who knows if perhaps you have come to the kingdom for such a time as this?  
(Esther 4:14)

### —WISDOM—

#### **Job — Suffering**

Though He slay me, yet will I trust in Him; I will maintain my ways before Him.  
(Job 13:15)

#### **Psalms — Worship**

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.  
(Psalm 23:1)

#### **Proverbs — Wisdom**

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline.  
(Proverbs 1:7)

#### **Ecclesiastes —**

##### **Vanity**

Fear God and keep His commandments, because this is the whole duty of man.  
(Ecclesiastes 12:13)

#### **Song of Solomon —**

##### **Love**

I am my beloved's and my beloved is mine; he browses among the lilies.  
(Song of Solomon 6:3)

### —PROPHECY—

#### **Isaiah — Salvation**

Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall become like wool.  
(Isaiah 1:18)

#### **Jeremiah —**

##### **Judgment**

For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans to prosper you and not to harm you, to give you a future and a hope.  
(Jeremiah 29:11)

#### **Lamentations —**

##### **Mourning**

Because of the LORD's loving devotion we are not consumed, for His mercies never fail. They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness!  
(Lamentations 3:22–23)

#### **Ezekiel — Glory**

I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will remove your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh.  
(Ezekiel 36:26)

#### **Daniel — Sovereignty**

He changes the times and the seasons; He removes kings and establishes them. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who know understanding.  
(Daniel 2:21)

#### **Hosea —**

##### **Faithfulness**

I will betroth you to Me forever; I will betroth you in righteousness and justice, in loving devotion and compassion.  
(Hosea 2:19)

#### **Joel — Renewal**

And it will come to pass afterward that I will pour out My Spirit on all people; your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams, your young men will see visions.  
(Joel 2:28)

#### **Amos — Justice**

But let justice roll on like a river, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream.  
(Amos 5:24)

#### **Obadiah — Pride**

The pride of your heart has deceived you, O dwellers in the clefts of the rock.  
(Obadiah 1:3)

#### **Jonah —**

##### **Compassion**

Then the word of the LORD came to Jonah a second time: 'Get up! Go to the great city of Nineveh and proclaim to it the message that I give you.'  
(Jonah 3:1–2)

**Micah — Justice**

He has shown you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to act justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God?

(Micah 6:8)

**Nahum — Vengeance**

The LORD is slow to anger and great in power; the LORD will by no means leave the guilty unpunished.

(Nahum 1:3)

**Habakkuk — Faith**

The righteous will live by his faith.

(Habakkuk 2:4)

**Zephaniah — Judgment**

The great day of the LORD is near—near and coming quickly! The cry on the day of the LORD is bitter; the Mighty Warrior shouts His battle cry.

(Zephaniah 1:14)

**Haggai — Priorities**

The glory of this latter house will be greater than the former, says the LORD of Hosts. And in this place I will provide peace.

(Haggai 2:9)

**Zechariah — Restoration**

Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit, says the LORD of Hosts.

(Zechariah 4:6)

**Malachi — Covenant**

Bring the full tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house. Test Me in this, says the LORD of Hosts, and see if I will not open the floodgates of heaven

and pour out a blessing without measure.

(Malachi 3:10)

## NEW TESTAMENT

### —GOSPELS—

**Matthew — Messiah**

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added unto you.

(Matthew 6:33)

**Mark — Servanthood**

For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.

(Mark 10:45)

**Luke — Compassion**

For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.

(Luke 19:10)

**John — Belief**

For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.

(John 3:16)

### —HISTORY—

**Acts — Mission**

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

(Acts 1:8)

### —LETTERS—

**Romans — Justification**

Therefore, since we have been justified

through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

(Romans 5:1)

**1 Corinthians — Unity**

Let all that you do be done in love.

(1 Corinthians 16:14)

**2 Corinthians — Strength**

My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is perfected in weakness.

(2 Corinthians 12:9)

**Galatians — Freedom**

It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm then, and do not be encumbered once more by a yoke of slavery.

(Galatians 5:1)

**Ephesians — Grace**

For it is by grace you have been saved through faith, and this not from yourselves; it is the gift of God.

(Ephesians 2:8)

**Philippians — Joy**

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!

(Philippians 4:4)

**Colossians — Supremacy**

He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.

(Colossians 1:17)

**1 Thessalonians — Hope**

For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a loud command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.

(1 Thessalonians 4:16)

**2 Thessalonians — Perseverance**

But as for you, brothers, do not grow weary in doing good.

(2 Thessalonians 3:13)

**1 Timothy — Godliness**

Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called.

(1 Timothy 6:12)

**2 Timothy — Endurance**

I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.

(2 Timothy 4:7)

**Titus — Good Works**

Show yourself in all respects to be an example of good works, with integrity, dignity, and sound speech.

(Titus 2:7–8)

**Philemon — Forgiveness**

Perhaps this is why he was separated from you for a while, so that you might have him back for good—no longer as a slave, but better than a slave, as a beloved brother.

(Philemon 1:15–16)

**Hebrews — Superiority**

Now faith is the assurance of what we hope for and the certainty of what we do not see.

(Hebrews 11:1)

**James — Works**

Be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

(James 1:22)

**1 Peter — Suffering**

But just as He who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do.

(1 Peter 1:15)

**2 Peter — Knowledge**

But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.

(2 Peter 3:18)

**1 John — Love**

We love because He first loved us.

(1 John 4:19)

**2 John — Truth**

And this is love: that we walk according to His commandments. This is the very commandment you have heard from the beginning, that you must walk in love.

(2 John 1:6)

**3 John — Faithfulness**

Beloved, do not imitate what is evil, but what is good. The one who does good is of God; the one who does evil has not seen God.

(3 John 1:11)

**Jude — Contend**

Contend earnestly for the faith once delivered to the saints.

(Jude 1:3)

### —PROPHECY—

**Revelation — Victory**

He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the former things have passed away.

(Revelation 21:4)
